**SECONDARY SCHOOLS** 



- School monitoring in primary and secondary schools that evaluates:
  - Key competences in different subjects (e.g., German, French, Mathematics achievement tests)
  - Central elements of the learning environment (e.g., class and school climate, motivation questionnaire)
- Legal basis (Loi du 6 février 2009 portant modification de la loi du 7 octobre 1993 ayant pour objet la création d'un SCRIPT)
- Educational Standards of the Luxembourgish curriculum as reference:
  - Evaluation whether the educational goals from the previous learning cycle were achieved by all students in the respective grade levels (C2.1, C3.1, C4.1, Grade 7 and Grade 9)
- ÉpStan systematically take student **background characteristics** into account:
  - Allows a fair performance comparison

# ÉPSTAN – IPS EXTENSION

- Stepwise extension of the ÉpStan to the International Public Schools:
  - Since 2022/2023 → Assessment of competences in mathematics (main test)
    - PI/Stage I, P3/Stage 3, P5/Stage 5 in primary school
    - SI/7<sup>e</sup> and S3/5<sup>e</sup> in **secondary** school



- Since 2024/2025 → Assessment of language competences in P3/Stage 3 (pretest)
- Student questionnaire in all grades participating in the ÉpStan
- **Parent questionnaire** in all primary school grades participating in the ÉpStan



🔎 NEW



- **Mandatory** for all students in the following grades:
  - Primary school: PI, P3 and P5
  - Secondary school: SI (if a tablet is available) and S3
- Students absent on the day of testing should be given the opportunity to take the test under standardized conditions on another date:
  - Supervision
  - Quiet space
  - Careful to use code and material according to your class list
- The same applies to the **student questionnaire**.



## PARTICIPATING STUDENTS

- Children with low knowledge of the school language (primo-arrivants)
  - Students should always try to take the mathematics tests (language free, translations possible)
  - Case-by-case decision for the language tests based on linguistic abilities
  - Students can work on the booklets to not feel excluded without the answers being coded
- Children with visual or auditory disorders
  - Allocation of additional testing time possible
  - Tests are **conducted separately** if necessary
- Children with developmental disorders
  - **Case-by-case decisions** taken by the teacher and the Direction de région/school management



# TEST DATES FOR THE MAIN TESTS

- Secondary school exact dates set by ÉpStan coordinators:
  - <u>Tablet-based test and student questionnaire</u> in **SI**:

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- Half a morning between 25<sup>th</sup> of November and 6<sup>th</sup> of December
- Alternatively, test dates from the **4**<sup>th</sup> of November onwards are possible
- <u>Computer-based test and student questionnaire</u> in **S3**:
  - Half a morning between 4<sup>th</sup> of November and 6<sup>th</sup> of December

Preparation (information about ÉpStan, test instructions, logging in)	20 minutes	e.g., 08:00 – 08:20
Competency test in mathematics	45 minutes	e.g., 08:20 – 09:05
Break	10 minutes	e.g., 09:05 – 09:15
Student questionnaire	20 minutes	e.g., 09:15 – 09:35



# **TEST ADMINISTRATION MANUALS**

- ÉpStan coordinators receive the needed material via e-mail
  - Distribution of material to test administrators and subject teachers



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Available for each:

- **Grade** (S1, S3)
- Language section (DE, FR, ENG)

As the tests are tablet- (SI) or computerbased (S3) in secondary school, the student answers are directly saved on our servers.

> No manual coding is needed!

# DATA PROTECTION

- **Pseudonymization procedure** in compliance with GDPR guidelines
- For each test, each student receives a unique numerical code
  - University only uses this code when evaluating the test and questionnaire data
  - No conclusions on the identity of individual students can be drawn
- In addition, each students is given a **constant, unique identifier:** 
  - Allows to follow students longitudinally without compromising their anonymity
- **Trusted Third Party** is doing the secure matching of these identifiers:
  - Neither the LUCET nor the Ministry have access to the test results of individual students



### COORDINATION

Carefully read the **manual** and, if applicable, the **presentation materials**.

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- If you have requested printed material: Check completeness until the <u>21<sup>st</sup> of October 2024</u>.
- Register test dates via timetable.epstan.lu (without www) until the <u>21<sup>st</sup> of October 2024</u>.
- Reserve computer labs and, if necessary, tablets (for the S1/7<sup>e</sup> classes).
- Download and print class lists and login sheets via epstan-ttp.itrust.lu (without www) until the <u>25<sup>th</sup> of October 2024</u>.
- Assign colleagues to supervise the test and questionnaire, and hand over all the necessary test materials by the <u>25<sup>th</sup> of October 2024</u>.
- Distribute the information letters and class lists to head and subject teachers until the <u>25<sup>th</sup></u>
   of October 2024.
- Add missing students via the ÉpStan-TTP-portal until the <u>20th of December 2024</u>.
